We understand the importance of providing our children with outdoor time and activities more than ever before. We will make sure to provide a fun and safe experience for your children. Our ability to run our camps is in accordance with County Safety Guidelines and State Health Orders as well as guidance from the CDC. It must be acknowledged, however, that the complete elimination of risk is not possible. We are confident that the steps we are taking will result in a low or limited risk environment for all children, parents and staff.

We encourage all camp families to adhere to health guidelines outside of Wikiup to limit contact in other areas of life, to practice sanitation and wear a mask when in public. If you, your child, or anyone you come into contact with show symptoms of COVID-19 you must refrain from attending camp, notify us immediately, and seek testing as soon as possible.

Below, we will outline specific steps being taken to limit the risk of COVID-19 spread and to comply with our local county's health order.

- All pods will be small groups of 10 or less (1 Counselor & 9 Campers)
- One counselor and campers will be in the same pod all week
- All counselors will wear face coverings while campers under 12 are not required
- Mandatory temperature readings for all staff and campers at check-in
- Pods will be socially distanced from other pods
- Proper sanitation for any shared equipment/spaces
- Provide your child with a healthy snack and water bottle

Parents must wear face covering when dropping off and picking up camper/s (one parent only)
